Rental Space Available at Local Music Centre

1 December 2020 – The Guelph Youth Music Centre (GYMC) is offering rental space for private lessons, classes, rehearsals, and meetings in accordance with current government restrictions and regulations.

"This is a difficult time for many of us, particularly music and the arts," commented Gabriella Currie-Ziegler, Executive Director of the GYMC. "However, the GYMC offers a great opportunity to continue lessons and provide meeting space in a safe environment for teachers, program leaders and their students."

Current orange level status for Wellington-Dufferin-Guelph allows for organized public events and gathering for up to 50 people indoors and 100 people outdoors, as well as private events and social gatherings for up to 10 people indoors and 25 people outdoors.

Rental space is perfect for certain instrument music lessons, which include strings (violin, viola, cello, bass), piano and percussion. In fact, any lessons, rehearsals, or classes that can ensure all participants, without exception, are wearing masks and social distancing, are eligible.

There are seven studio rooms (small, medium and large), one dance studio with sprung floor and one recital hall available. Rental rates, appointments and tours are available by calling 519-837-1119.

The GYMC has strict safety protocols in place, including a liability release form and a COVID-19 questionnaire/waiver, which are mandatory for all staff and visitors to complete before entering the building. See the GYMC website at gymc.ca for details.
